## Goals of the County Level Impact Study

- Examine impacts on early child overweight and obesity in Los Angeles County as a whole.

**Obesity= BMI ≥ 95th percentile**  
**Overweight= BMI ≥ 85th percentile**

## RECO Overview

First 5 Los Angeles funded RECO investments to adopt a wide variety of strategies to address early childhood obesity at the following levels:



**Individual**



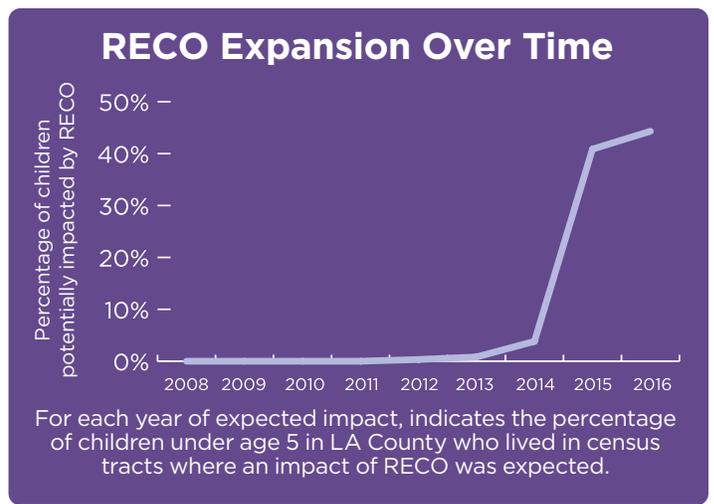
**Community**

## LA County Characteristics

- Geographically larger than 4,000 square miles.
- One of the most racially/ethnically diverse counties in the U.S.
- Most populous county in the U.S.

## Methodology

- Unique characteristics of LA County mean no other CA county is an appropriate comparison
- Solution: Synthetic Comparison Method
  - Create “synthetic” LA County = weighted combination of other Southern CA counties similar to LA County before RECO
  - Impact = divergence between synthetic and actual LA County after start of RECO, accounting for expansion of RECO over time

## RECO County-Level Impact

**Child Overweight**

↓ **2.16** percentage points



**Child Obesity**

↓ **.67** percentage points





**RECO reduced early childhood overweight and obesity in LA County.**

Percentage point difference in rates of early childhood overweight and obesity between LA County and the synthetic comparison county at the height of RECO.
